- What kind of excitement and attention do you think was generated by what Luke describes in verses 16?
- Luke reveals the motives of the Sadducees in **verse 17**. Why do you think that information is important?
- Why is it ironic that God would send an angel to release the apostles who had been imprisoned by the Sadducees?
- Why do you think the Religious Leaders never asked the apostles how they got out of the prison?
- What does Peter say about obedience in verse 29?
- Why were the Religious leaders enraged?
- What was Gamaliel's argument?
- How did the Sanhedrin respond to what Gamaliel said?
- What does verse 42 tell you about how the disciples received the threats of the Religious Leaders?
- What do you feel was the most important truth from this study?
