- Read also **Hebrews 11:6** and explain why it applies to Cain and Abel's offerings to the Lord?
- Compare Genesis 4:3–7 to Isaiah 1:10–20; Jeremiah 7:21–24, and Amos 5:21–24. Under what circumstances does God reject acts of worship?
- Did Cain have a right to be angry in **4:5**? Why or why not? (see 4:6–7)
- Did Cain repent of his sin? How can you tell?
- What do you learn about Cain's character from the way he treated and spoke of his brother in **4:8–9**?
- How did God punish Cain for his sin?
- Why did God place a mark on Cain? What was the purpose of the mark?
- What does it reveal about God based on the way He responded to Cain's sin?
- What do you think it means that Cain "went away from the presence of the Lord"? (4:16)
- How would you respond to someone who asked where Cain got his wife?
- How is the presence of sin illustrated in the life and actions of Lamech? (4:19-24)
- How does the birth of Seth and the comment made in **4:26** shed hope on an otherwise hopeless chapter?
- What is the purpose of Genesis chapter 5?
- What did Noah's father say about Noah when he was born? (5:29)
