Concluding Exhortations:

Brotherly Love :1

- Practically speaking, what does it mean to love someone with “brotherly love?”
- Where do you see brotherly love being shown the best today?

Entertain Strangers :2

- Read **1 Peter 4:9** Why do you think people would “grumble” about showing hospitality?
- What are modern ways of showing hospitality that we can offer?

Remember those in prison :3

- We know what remembering people in prison meant to those living under Roman rule, but how can we respond to this exhortation today?

Honor Marriage /Keep the marriage bed undefiled :4

- Why is it so important to honor marriage and keep the marriage bed pure?
- Name all the ways we can honor marriage today?

Keep yourself from the love of money :5-6

- What fears does the author imply often lie at the root of the love of money?
- How does he try to disperse these fears?
- Read **Luke 12:15–21**. What is the message Jesus is conveying in this passage regarding money?

Remember your leaders :7

- In what areas should Christian leaders be a good example?
- How can we imitate the faith of our Christian leaders?

Jesus the same, yesterday, today and forever :8

- Why does this statement declare the deity of Jesus?
- What are the implications of Jesus never changing?

Do not be carried away by strange teachings :9

- What is the best way to steer clear of false and misleading teachings?

Let us go to Him outside the camp

- What does the term “outside the camp” mean both literally and figuratively?
- What is the main theme that the author is trying to get across in these verses?
- How do these verses speak to us today?
- What is the “city” that we are seeking?
