

Study questions for John 4 (Part 1) v1-24

- **Verses 1-3** tell us that Jesus made the decision to travel to Galilee when He discovered that the Pharisees were aware that His popularity was growing. Why do you think Jesus decided that that was a good time to move northward?
- Didn't Jesus normally stand up to the Pharisees and even condemn their practices? Why is this time different?
- What do we learn about Jesus in **verse 6**?
- One of the key aspects about evangelism is breaking barriers. What are some ways we can break barriers with those around us in order to have chances to share the gospel with them?
- What was the Samaritan woman's reaction? How did she perceive Jesus' request?
- How did Jesus answer her question in verse 10?
- What is Living Water?
- What does Jesus tell us that Living Water produces in the life of the believer?
- Why do you think Jesus asked the woman to go and get her husband?
- How much do you think the woman understood about what Jesus was saying?
- Why do you think when we are unbelievers we are so clueless about our longing for eternal life?
- What things can we learn from this conversation about evangelism?
