

Questions, Reflections & Prayer Points

Now that you've listened to the teaching on Joshua chapter 11 and 12, go through the questions below and use some paper or your computer to write down your answers.

Questions:

1. Joshua was faced with an even bigger army in chapter 11 than he had seen up to this point. What is your reaction when you are faced with challenges that are far beyond your own personal ability to conquer?
2. During the northern campaign how did Joshua demonstrate his obedience to the Lord?
3. List the reasons why you think walking in obedience is especially hard when we're facing an especially strong enemy?
4. List the areas where the Lord wants to see you walking in a greater expression of obedience.

Reflect on the following statements:

Just when it seems as if the Lord brings us to a place of victory and confidence in His ability to provide, we are then faced with an even bigger challenge to draw out more faith than before. Think about reasons why God does this.

Think about how your faith has been tested in the past year. How have you done?

Look over the list you made above about areas where the Lord would have you walk in obedience—draw a circle around the ones that challenge your faith the most.

Prayer Points:

- Pray for a heart of obedience
- Ask the Lord to give you courage to walk uprightly even when you're facing overwhelming odds
- Ask the Lord to help you walk by faith and not by sight
