Now that you've listened to the teaching on Joshua chapter 13 and 14, go through the questions below and use some paper or your computer to write down your answers.

Questions:

1. When you think about possessing all that Christ has for you, what areas of God's promises do you see that are still unoccupied in your life?
2. What should a Christian do if they sense they are satisfied with less than God has for them?
3. List some of the secrets that we looked at in chapter 14 that highlight the greatness of Caleb.

Reflections:

Quote: "We first open our hearts to receive Christ, and then by a living faith we possess Him."

We cannot possess all that Jesus has prepared for us until He first possesses us.

Caleb was 85 years old, but he didn't look for an easy task, suited to an "old man." He asked Joshua for mountains to climb and giants to conquer. His strength was in the Lord and he knew that God would never fail him

Prayer Points:

1. Pray that God would increase your faith to take more and more of what He has promised for you in Christ.
2. Using the things you listed above about the character of Caleb, spend some time asking the Lord to work those traits into your own life.
3. Ask the Lord to give you a heart like Caleb's, that never falters or wavers in unbelief but that keeps pressing on IN FAITH to receive all the Lord has for you.
