Now that you've listened to the teaching on Joshua chapter 1, go through the questions below and use some paper or your computer to re-write the question along with your own personal response.

Question 1: The first part of the chapter is a message from God to Joshua. Pick ONE WORD from the text that you feel best describes what God wanted Joshua to know.

Question 2: The promise of blessing for the Israelites centered around the land of Canaan. It was a physical blessing. Read Ephesians 1:3 and write down what blessings have been promised to you.

Question 3: God outlined the entire area that was being given to Israel, describing where it started and where it stopped. But we know the Jews never occupied all of it. In the same way, we fail to lay hold of everything that God has promised us as well. List some of the reasons below:

Question 4: If it were you God was exhorting instead of Joshua, what kinds of things would He say about the battles and enemies that you face?

Prayer Points:

- Look again at the ONE WORD you wrote down in question 1. Now ask the Lord how that word applies to your life, and what He wants to teach about that one thing.
- God encouraged Joshua to be "strong and courageous" because we all tend to struggle with weakness and fear. Take some time to pray about the things that make you weak at the knees and ask God to be your strength.
- God outlined to Joshua the priority of trusting the Lord. Ask the Lord to make trusting Him even more to be the priority of your heart.
