

# Questions, Reflections & Prayer Points

Now that you've listened to the teaching on Joshua chapter 5 and 6, go through the questions below and use some paper or your computer to write down your answers.

## Questions:

1. What is the difference between asking the Lord to take our side and setting our hearts to follow His plan?
2. What in the passage tells you absolutely that the "Commander of the Lord's Army" was the Lord God Himself?
3. What lessons do you think the Lord was teaching Israel during the seven days of marching around Jericho?
4. Why didn't God want the people to take any of the spoils of the city for themselves?
5. What is a theophany?

## Reflections:

- Think about how Israel was told to "attack" the city of Jericho and think about what God is teaching us about spiritual warfare.
- God told Joshua that the city and its contents were "devoted to the Lord" as firstfruits of the Canaanite victories. Think about ways the Lord might have you honor Him in this same way.
- Read Ephesians 6: 10-18 and think about how that passage relates to being ready for spiritual battles?

## Prayer:

- Ask the Lord to increase your faith.
- Pray for discernment to know when you're facing a spiritual battle
- Pray that God would give you insight into His battle plan for the issues you're facing in your life. Then pray for courage to carry them out, especially if they don't make sense.
